



We have players spread across various clubs in summer - so if you are not participating yourself, get down and enjoy some high quality baseball while





















Construction Schedule

September 18th - October 18th

- Site Establishment & Site Clearing
- Initial Earthworks
- Survey set out re all drainage works including the concrete cricket wicket location and rotating the infield anti clockwise (remove short right field)

October 18th - November 25th

- Installation of drainage system
- Concrete Wicket installation,
 & Reinstate Baseball Diamond

November 25th – December 10th

- Final Earthworks continued
 & Install Irrigation heads
- Supply and Lay Santa Ana couch

December 10th to March 2025

Maintenance of Ground for 13 weeks.








